The 2000 vintage produced exceptional fruit, resulting in Eugene Wine Cellars deciding to increase its production. All processing, fermentation, barrel or tank storage was handled on site at the winery.

Bruce Biehl is the executive winemaker for Eugene Wine Cellars. His vision is to produce wines which represent true varietal characteristics – fresh, aromatic and approachable. The wines are made in small batches, enabling Bruce and the winemaking staff to produce wines of intense flavors.

Many fine establishments in Oregon proudly offer their wines - which has only been available in 6 other states excluding California.
